This Air Tahiti Nui AIRBUS A340-300 is a model based on the AIRBUS A340-300 airplane which connects Tahiti and Tokyo's Narita airport, from the French Polynesian airline Air Tahiti Nui. The tail is decorated with a picture of a pure white Tiare flower, the national flower of Tahiti, and each plane is named after one of Tahiti's islands, with names such as "The Bora Bora." Onboard, flight attendants welcome passengers with the wonderful hospitality Tahitian people are known for.

The AIRBUS A340-300 measures 63.7m in length, with a wingspan of 60.3m and a height of 16.91m. It has a maximum weight of 275.0 tons, and a flight distance of 10.400km.

This model was designed for Papercraft and may differ from the original in some respects.
